Short Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive at Uttarkashi.

- **Altitude Uttarkashi:** 3,822 Ft.
- **Drive Duration:** 140 km approx. | 5 to 6 Hours

Day 2: Drive from Uttarkashi to Sangamchatti and Trek to Bebra via Agoda.

- **Altitude:** 7500 Ft.
- **Drive Distance Uttarkashi To Sangamchatti:** 12 km | 45 Minutes to 1 Hours
- **Trek Distance:** 7 km | 4 to 5 Hours

Day 3: Bebra to Manjhi.

- **Altitude:** 9,433 Ft.
- **Trek Distance:** 9 km | 4 to 5 Hours

Day 4: Manjhi to Dodital.

- **Altitude:** 10,900 Ft.
- **Trek Distance:** 6 km | 3 to 4 Hours

Day 5: Dodital to Darwa Top and Back to Dodital.

- **Altitude Pauni Gharat:** 13,300 Ft.
- **Trek Distance:** 5 km (one way) | 7 to 8 Hours

Day 6: Dodital to Sangamchatti & Drive to Uttarkashi.

- **Trek Distance:** 22 km | 6 to 7 Hours
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Day 7: Uttarkashi to Dehradun.

- **Drive Duration:** 140 km approx. | 5 to 6 Hours



DAY: 01



Dehradun to Uttarkashi

Your journey begins in Dehradun, from where you will drive to Uttarkashi. The scenic route takes you through lush valleys, winding mountain roads, and breathtaking views of the Himalayas.

Upon arrival, check into your hotel and take the rest of the day to relax and explore the surroundings. You can visit the famous Vishwanath Temple or stroll around the town before preparing for the trek.



DAY: 02



Drive from Uttarkashi to Sangamchatti and Trek to Bebra via Agoda

After an early breakfast, embark on a short drive to Sangamchatti, the starting point of your trek. The trail passes through quaint mountain villages like Agoda, where you can witness the daily lifestyle of the locals.

The trek to Bebra is moderate, featuring gradual ascents through dense forests of oak, rhododendron, and pine trees. Upon reaching Bebra, settle into your tents and enjoy the serene atmosphere.



DAY: 03



Bebra to Manjhi

The trail from Bebra to Manjhi presents a steady ascent, offering stunning landscapes of alpine meadows and forests. The trek takes you past lush green fields, gushing streams, and towering peaks in the distance.

Manjhi is a beautiful campsite with vast open grounds, making it an ideal place to rest and take in the breathtaking Himalayan views.



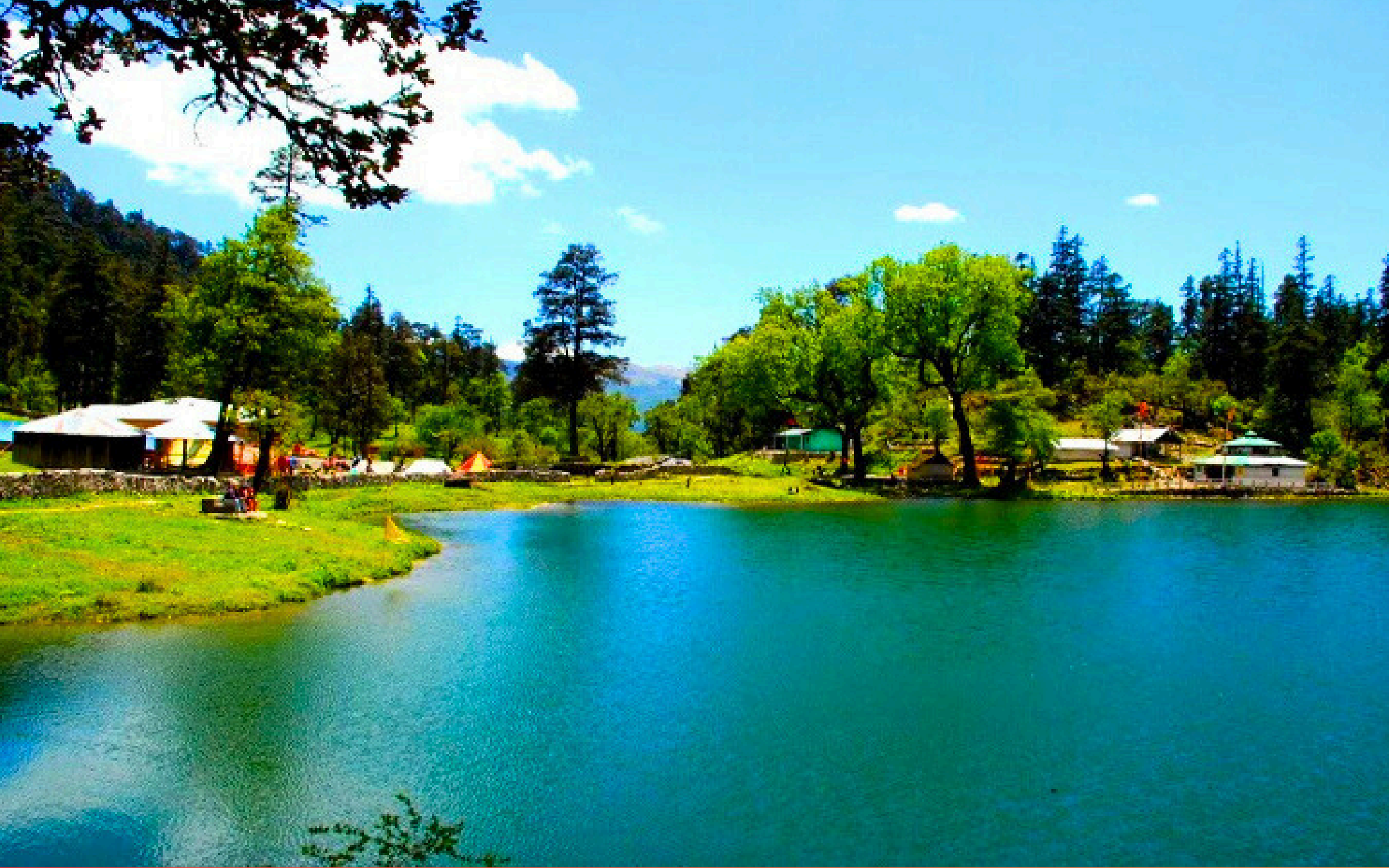
DAY: 04



Manjhi to Dodital

The trek to Dodital is shorter but filled with mesmerizing views of snow-capped peaks and thick pine forests. Dodital Lake, also known as the "Emerald Lake," is a pristine high-altitude lake surrounded by deodar and oak trees.

It is considered sacred and is believed to be the birthplace of Lord Ganesha. Upon arrival, explore the lake, visit the temple nearby, and soak in the tranquility of the surroundings.



DAY: 05



Dodital to Darwa Top and Back to Dodital

This day involves a challenging yet rewarding trek to Darwa Top, the highest point of the trek. The steep ascent is demanding but offers panoramic views of the snow-clad peaks of the Garhwal Himalayas, including Bandarpunch and Swargarohini.

Spend some time at the top, capturing breathtaking photos before heading back to Dodital for the night.



DAY: 06



Dodital to Sangamchatti & Drive to Uttarkashi

After an early breakfast, start your descent towards Sangamchatti. The downhill trek is long but offers a different perspective of the landscapes you passed earlier.

Upon reaching Sangamchatti, take a short drive back to Uttarkashi and check into your hotel. You can relax or explore the local market in the evening.



DAY: 07



Uttarkashi to Dehradun

Leave Uttarkashi early in the morning and drive back to Dehradun. Breakfast and lunch are not included on this day, so plan accordingly.

You will be dropped off at Dehradun Railway Station by 3-4 pm, allowing you to book your onward journey after 6 pm.

Exclusion

- Any kind of Travel / Health Insurance (Himalaya Yatri strictly recommend each traveller to please carry your own travel / health insurance).
- Trekking Shoes, Trekking Jacket, Trekking Sticks.
- Any Meals / Snacks / Beverages in during trip.
- Any of Cost for Airfare, Train fare.
- Any kind of medical expenses.
- Accommodation and Meals in Dehradun (Will be subject to additional cost).
- Any tips, laundry, Phone call, liquors, mineral water, camera fee or any other personal nature expenses.
- Airport pickup and drop services (Will be subject to additional cost).
- Any other fee / charges not mentioned in the cost included section.
- Backpack offloading charges, the backpack should not weigh more than 10 kgs. Suitcases/strollers/duffel bags will not be allowed (Subject to additional cost).
